# Windrush 75: Family Treasures

*Be a part of my forthcoming exhibition*



This year marks the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the arrival of SS Windrush in 1948.

As part of the celebrations, I will be staging a major new photography exhibition following on from my 2018 exhibition, 'Windrush: Portrait of a Generation', which marked the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Having discovered some wonderful new stories, I am particularly interested in how the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> generations are keeping alive their Caribbean heritage, culture, and traditions.

I am very keen to include the younger generation's 'voice' in my new exhibition and so I am seeking to assemble a set of 75 photographs created by the 3<sup>rd</sup> (and even 4<sup>th</sup>!) generation.

It's very simple (and fun!) to take part, please turn over for how to participate.

If you are aged 16 or under, with Caribbean heritage, and would like to participate:

1. Please choose a single object, large or small, that is precious to one of your family or relations and which, in one way or another, is connected with either your family's Caribbean heritage and culture or your family's 'story'.
2. Place it on a piece of Caribbean related fabric. It could be a piece of actual Caribbean fabric...it could be your grandmother's dress or blouse...it could be an old tea-towel...whatever is easiest. Please brush the fabric flat.
3. Take a photograph (in landscape format as shown in the examples) with a mobile phone or tablet.
4. E-mail your photo (with the highest res/biggest file possible on your phone) to me at [jim.grover@mac.com](mailto:jim.grover@mac.com).
5. Please include the following information with your photo:
  - a. What is the object?
  - b. Which of your relations does/did it belong to?
  - c. Why have you chosen it? Just a few words or a couple of sentences.
  - d. What is your first/Christian name...and your age on June 1<sup>st</sup> 2023?
6. Send the photo and the information no later than April 30<sup>th</sup>.

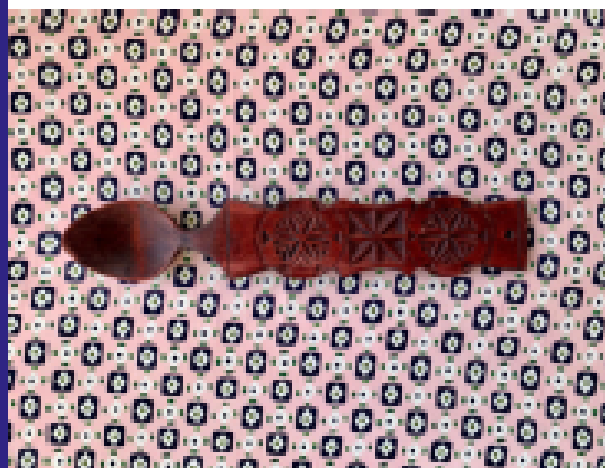
I will include the first 75 photos that I receive in my exhibition which opens on June 1<sup>st</sup> and runs for 3 months in Clapham.
