

All about our Forest School



Forest School is a unique way of bringing the great outdoors experience Into the familiar school environment. Our Forest School is used by children in all year groups, providing opportunity to play, design and create in the context of a woodland environment in a small group.

Activities are scaffolded by an adult, with the children then self-directing throughout the session. This is an important element of Forest School as it enables children to develop skills in leadership, collaboration, risk assessment as well as applying their curriculum knowledge in a real life context.

Our Forest School has been received well by the children and staff, creating an inclusive learning and exploration environment.

Equal, unique and valuable.

Competent to explore & discover.

Entitled to experience appropriate risk and challenge.

Entitled to choose, and to initiate and drive their own learning and development Entitled to experience regular success.
