Upcoming Events;

Next half term the children will be learning about Bridges. They will all take part in an architecture workshop where they will experience something that will stay with them throughout their educational life.

Our Bridges, Maths & Design workshop runs for 120 minutes with up to 45 pupils. Working individually then in teams pupils are taken through the stages to make a 2m long truss, which they are challenged to make stand with a limited amount of extra materials. During this process workshop they will learn how triangles can be used to make 2d and 3d shapes strong. They will also be introduced to three different common bridge types; beam, cantilever and suspension.
